Volunteer Agreement and Guidelines

- Treat animals, customers, employees of adoption sites and other volunteers with courtesy and respect at all times.
- Ask another volunteer or board member with any questions if you are not absolutely sure of the answer. Do NOT make up an answer. We want to give people the honest and correct answers when they ask.
- Maintain confidentiality regarding owner surrenders, adoptions and general rescue business.
- Dress comfortably and appropriately to all adoption events. Old clothing may be necessary to wear as you are working with animals and your clothes may become stained or dirty. Please do not wear clothing with suggestive of offensive language/content. Volunteers dressed inappropriately will be asked to change clothing.
- Immediately report to another volunteer any accident or injury to an individual or animal.
- Realize that animals can be unpredictable at times and may bite or scratch. Read the animal's body language before handling and do not handle any animal if it makes you uncomfortable.
- While at adoption events, do NOT let potential adopters walk off with the animal. If they would like to take them for a walk, keep a close eye on them or walk along with them.
- Do not walk small puppies in grass areas at adoption events. They can contract diseases and illnesses from feces left in the grass.
- Be honest to potential adopters about an animal regarding any behavioral, social or aggressive tendencies the animal may possess.
- We want to tell everyone the truth about each animal up for adoption. We want adoptions to be the best situation for both the animals and adopter and make sure they are a good match. We do not want to have a person make a decision or feel pressure to take an animal. This could make an animal come back to our rescue.
